Engage in meaningful interactions

By focusing on relationships and holistic experiences children will be engaged. Through these interactions educators can get to see the children's strengths and how to challenge children.

Notice the children's learning and skills

Children are learning all the time and focusing on relationships will allow this to be seen. This will also take the stress off seeking out observations and will allow them to come easily, by noticing the valuable moments.

Plan to build on interests, and resource children's learning

Completing the planning cycle means understanding how to keep children learning and engaged based on our knowledge of them as individuals. Build on the interest, allow for further exploration and investigation, allow children to revisit and research.

Document the experience

Share the relationship, the learning and the children's strengths through documentation. Give the children a voice, involve the role of the educator, make the learning clear to families to help them appreciate our skills and training as qualified educators.
