

# 6 ways to share the learning with families



## Displays

Include information on how children learned during the experience when making displays



## Conversations

Focus on the curriculum and child's progress during discussions at pick up and drop off times



## Visibility

Avoid hiding the learning behind codes or symbols and discuss the learning in documentation



## Newsletters

Explore a different aspect of your curriculum and how this supports children's learning



## Be Professional

Ensure you remain professional in discussions with families to build their trust and respect



## Knowledge

Draw on your knowledge of the learning framework and child development to share confidently

Remember: It is not the responsibility of the families to learn and understand the learning framework content. It is our responsibility as educators to unpack and share this information in a way that families can understand.

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
